NEIGHBOURHOOD PLAN STEERING GROUP

MINUTES 17th March 2025

- 1. Present were; Steve Smith (SS), Gary Butler (GB), and Lindsey Malcom (LM)
- 2. Apologies from Nigel Holmes (NH) and Mike Parker (MP)
- 3. This was a zoom meeting with Leah from ONH and the SEA team. We discussed all sites and a summary of the initial review is below;
 - Site 1. Possible site, but access is difficult. Would be better of site 5 goes forward.
 - Site 2. No obvious constraints, it will need a review. Possibly build on the north part only and make the south part a public green space.
 - Site 3. Could be up to 5 houses, but probably 3 due to the TPOs.
 - Site 4. A more detailed assessment is needed by the SEA, pointed out it was last in the village vote.
 - Site 5. No immediate constraints. Shown as low capacity and it is high sensitivity. Leaves the historic centre of the village untouched. Would need a SANG.
 - Site 6. Probably ruled out because of woodland and the flood risk. Should be okay for the 2 houses originally applied for.
 - Site 7. Ruled out because of woodland and flood risk. It is a potential SANG for site 2.
 - Site 8. Possible car park, etc, if site 5 goes ahead.

Question was discussed, should we look at different levels of growth to have options for NFDC.
